News in Brief



e-GP training conducted by GPPMD for all the staff of CDB

GPPMD, Department of National Properties conducted e-GP training for the incumbents of the CDB from 5th July 2021 to 7th July 2021, which is anticipated to enhance the procurement process through the use of e-GP system and empowering all the trained officials as focal person in carrying out any procurement task assigned.

Building Information Modeling (BIM) training to construction professionals in collaboration with Construction Institute of Thailand (CIT) & Engineering Institute of Thailand (EIT)

Since the signing of MoU with CIT, Thailand and as a part of institutional linkage activity, the introductory seminars on Building Information Modeling (BIM) have been facilitated by them and to this effect, 102 professionals which includes the CDB engineers, contractors, specialized firms and consultants have been trained in two batches.

Training for Safety Officer in collaboration with CAB and with representation from MoLHR, MoWHS and CDB in two batches

Facilitated 2 batches of Safety Officer training for Large and Medium Class contractors in collaboration with CAB and with representation from MoLHR, MoWHS and CDB.



Construction Safety Supervisor Training Course Outline

Occupational health and safety is defined by the International Labour Organization as "the promotion and maintenance of highest degree of physical, social and mental well-being of workers in all occupations". It has been globally understood that workplace safety culture plays a pivotal role in worker efficiency.

In light of circumstances stated above, the Construction Development Board (CDB) in collaboration with the Department of Labour, MoLHR, the Construction Association of Bhutan (CAB) and Japan International Cooperation Agency (JICA) drafted the Construction Safety Supervisor Training Course Outline from 27th Sept. to 2nd Oct 2021. The safety training will aim to raise awareness about the existing legislations related to OHS in the country, introduce the concept of OHS and skill the trainees with basic knowledge pertinent in maintaining OHS at the construction site.



Refresher course for contractors conducted virtually from 12th July – 20th July [2 batches], 20th – 22nd Sept [1 Batch], 20th Oct – 26th Oct [2 Batches], 13th Dec – 24th Dec [2 Batches]. The objective of the program is to enhance professionalism in Construction Industry and it is also pegged with renewal of CDB Registration Certificate.

Induction course for aspiring contractors conducted from 23rd August – 8th September [1401 registered - 13 Batches & 27th Dec - 30th Dec. [534 registered- 4 Batches] - virtually. The objective of the program is to familiarize and introduce new contractors to construction industry.



Construction Quality Compliance Mechanism (CQCM) project (World Bank)

To augment the quality issues in the construction industry, CDB under CQCM project formulated publication of Construction Industry Quality Gap Analysis & Recommendations which will be instrumental in drafting CQCM framework.

Integration of e-TOOL and e-GP: Phase II

To avoid duplication of work and data redundancy, the e-TOOL and e-GP are further integrated, where the evaluation criteria and bidder's details are automatically pulled to e-TOOL from e-GP, the task of integration was carried out through the funding from GPPMD, Department of National Properties, Ministry of Finance.

Launched of e-Registration Certificate for all CDB services w.e.f. 11th November 2021

CDB launched the revised e-Certificate for registered firms and individuals coinciding with the 66th Birth Anniversary of 4th Druk Gyalpo. The revised ecertificate contains more information related to the firms or individuals.

Coursera Course

To enhance professionalism and to develop an efficient and quality-based construction industry CDB purchased 24 licenses from Coursera Team on Building Information Modeling (BIM). The course was offered to engineer, architects, designers, urban planners. The coursera is an online learning platform and most of the courses are available with a pre-recorded lecturers and experts from leading universities and companies.





In continuation to the earlier notification dated December 24, 2020 posted in our website deferring the regulation of CDB registered Engineers employed by the Construction/ Consultancy firms due to second nationwide lockdown of COVID-19 pandemic.

In this regard, all Construction/Consultancy firms are hereby notified to inform your engineers to register with CDB immediately.

Failing to comply with this notification shall result in suspension for those valid certificate or denial of renewal of your CDB registration certificate.

This is to notify all the construction firms that as per Clause 4.2 and Annexure 2 of Monitoring (Amendment) guidelines 2020 and the notification issued by Ministry of Works and Human Settlement vide MoWHS/2020/20/122 dated June 18, 2020. Construction Development Board shall hereby monitor the availability of the following at the construction sites:

- Safety In-charge/representative
- Safety signages
- 3. Fire extinguishing equipment
- 4. First aid tool box with aid kits
- 5. Peripheral boundary of construction site (securing of site)
- Safe and proper electrical connections and installations: and
- 7. Other personnel protective equipment (safety helmet, safety shoes, high visibility vest, safety goggle, welding shield, dust mask, safety harness/belts, protective gloves, ear plugs/muffs etc.)
