Criteria to select Top Performing contractors

Objective

- To recognize performing CDB registered Contractors in the Construction Industry; and
- Identify pool of capable firms to award works directly during emergency situations¹.

Target Group (Scope)

- Top 10 in W1 category (Road and Bridge works) in Large, Medium and Small.
- Top 10 in W3 Category (Building works) in Large, Medium and Small.

CDB shall update the list of top performing Contractors in different work Categories and Class quarterly in the CDB website.

Turn over score of the $Firm(x) = 100x \frac{Total\ Turn\ over\ of\ the\ firm\ in\ last\ five\ years}{Turn\ over\ of\ the\ firm\ having\ highest\ turn\ over}$

APS score of the Firm(y) = $100x \frac{Average\ APS\ score\ of\ the\ firm\ in\ last\ five\ years}{APS\ of\ the\ firm\ having\ Highest\ APS\ score}$

Tax paid by the Firm(z) = $100x \frac{Tax \text{ paid by the firm in last five years}}{Tax \text{ paid by the firm having Highest Tax paid}}$

Total score of the firm = 0.5*x+0.4*y+0.1z

¹ An 'emergency' is a sudden unforeseen event which can result in injury, loss of life or critical damage to property or Infrastructure or economic loss.

² Adverse records are defined as, 1. Project termination in last 2 years. 2. Firm convicted by The Court in any form in last 2 years 3. Administrative action taken by CDB in last 1 year.

³ Tax paid is the total tax the Firm is liable to pay from the taxable income or profit as per the data in RAMIS of DRC,MoF.
